What is the process?

- 3. Complete your research booklet /24 marks in BRIEF POINT FORM NOTES. (see the rubric)
- 4. Include all of the resources you have used for your research. You must use A MINIMUM OF THREE SOURCES (none can be Wikipedia), and you must also use at least one print source.

The Research Essay

Requires you to present your information in a multi-paragraph format. You will need a title page, an introduction, 6 body paragraphs (one to address each of your research questions) to present your research, and a concluding paragraph. Each paragraph must be at least 7-8 sentences and include information from at least two different sources.
